

LCOR Indoor Worship Guidelines

Indoors: Maximum 50% capacity or up to 50 people in the sanctuary at one time.

- If you are not feeling well, have a cough, fever (greater than 100°), sore throat, or other cold/flu like symptoms including nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, extreme fatigue, chills, muscle aches, or loss of taste or smell, or new shortness of breath, you are asked to stay home. If you have been around anyone who has tested positive please stay home.
- Per the governor's order, we request all attendees over 10 years-old wear a mask while in the building.
- Sign screening sheet upon entering and answer all questions.
- Please keep a 6 foot distance between your family unit and others.
- All areas in the building beyond the bathrooms, including the nursery, will remain closed at this time.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building. Please use often for your protection as well as other members
- We ask that you not congregate in groups anywhere within the building.
- Prayer requests and announcements will need to be emailed or called to the church by Friday (there will be no announcements made by members during the service).
- Offering will be collected by the doors when entering or exiting the sanctuary. You may still utilize the online giving options or mail in your offering.
- Please sit with your family unit all in one pew. We ask that you do not bring in outside food or drinks.
- Communion elements can be picked up on your way into the sanctuary for self-service during the appropriate time.
- At this time we will not have any activity bags for children.
- Lector will need to wear their mask to and from the podium and then remove it for the readings.
- When exiting the sanctuary, keep 6 foot of distance between your family unit and others (exit back pew first, and so on keeping 6 foot distance).
